This agricultural landscape looks like a soft, undulating carpet, completely otherworldly, as if it had been created by Al. In addition to erosion, the problem with these intensively cultivated areas is also the increasing exhaustion of fertile soil.



	The Haenyeo 'sea-mermaids' of Jeju are women who free dive for hours at a time in search of ocean treasures such as abalone and sea urchins. This do this without scuba gear, the way they have been doing it for over a thousand years. I followed closely behind the women making their way to the tip of the volcanic shore for a long day ahead. I captured bursts of color against the backdrop of a gloomy day: neon orange buoys, bright green nets, purple rubber soles. As the women were getting ready for their daily dive, I was preparing myself for an adventure among them. They stay close together in the water, as they do on land. In the background, a fishing boat and ferry zoom by, a strange juxtaposition of the old and the new. The Haenyeo pay no attention to them. They are focused on their work. One woman tells me later that the ocean is as dangerous as it is beautiful. Many women have lost their lives at sea. I followed them with my lens as they disappeared and reappeared from the sea, the only constant was their orange buoys. Yellow flippers in the air and a small splash create the foreground. The sea appears so unperturbed around the Haenyeo. In the distance, waves crash over strips of volcanic rock. 
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
